- Valid Nominators are dependent on GRP having state party status or not (see back side).
- Five (5) valid nominators are required (suggested to get more than 5 to be sure)
- Nominators print name, sign, print town. (Please do NOT mark in the OK Column.)
- Candidates are strongly encouraged to submit a statement of why they are running for the position.

Valid Nominators

When Green-Rainbow Party has State Party Status, valid nominators:

- for officers of the party (Co-Chairs, Secretary and Treasurer) must be voters registered in the Green-Rainbow party
- for directors of the party (Fundraising, Membership and Communication), representatives to other organizations (eg. GPUS) or diversity members may be any member of the party (either voters registered in the Green-Rainbow Party or donors to the party who are not registered in another party or can not register to vote)

When Green-Rainbow Party is a political designation, valid nominators:

- for officers of the party (Co-Chairs, Secretary and Treasurer), directors of the party (Fundraising, Membership and Communication), representatives to other organizations (eg. GPUS) or diversity members, may be any member of the party (either voters registered in the Green-Rainbow Party or donors to the party who are not registered in another party or can not register to vote)

Candidates for Officers and Directors of the Green-Rainbow Party are always required to be members who are registered to vote as Green-Rainbow. Diversity members may be any type of member of the Green-Rainbow Party.
